Question Summary

An image is displayed inside a <div>. The diagram shows 15 pixels of space on all sides between the image and the container border. Complete the first line of the CSS rule for div so that the spacing is correct.

Worked Solution

To create equal space inside the container around the image, you add padding to the div. Padding sits between the element 's content (the image) and its border. A single value applies to all four sides (top, right, bottom, left).

Required first line in the CSS rule:

padding: 15px;

Final Answer

Use padding on the container:

div { padding: 15px; } (This gives 15 px spacing on all four sides between the image and the border.)

Revision Tips

- Padding = space inside the border; margin = space outside the border.
- One-value padding applies to all sides; two/three/four values target specific sides.
- Keep container width consistent with desired layout; avoid duplicate width declarations.
